Rules:

- 1. The age of the oldest member determines the competition age group. Example: A 9 & 11-year-old presenting together would be in the 10-13 age group.
- 2. Endorsement of brand names is discouraged.
- 3. Handouts or samples for judges are acceptable.
- 4. The entire presentation must be the original work of the 4-H member and abide by all copyright laws. All images and music must be cited correctly.
- 5. You must present your presentation in person.
- 6. The judge will serve as the timekeeper.
- 7. Topics, visuals, props, language, and attire should be family-friendly and not violate the Kansas 4-H Code of Conduct.
- 8. Judge will deduct one ribbon placing if time is exceeded by more than 30 seconds.
