#### **Rules:**

- 1. Participants select all or a portion of a one speech previously given by someone else in a historical setting, such as Washington's Inaugural Address, Lincoln's Gettysburg Address, Sojourner Truths' "Ain't I a Woman" Speech, Reagan's "Tear Down This Wall" Speech.
- 2. The original speaker and the setting for the selection should be introduced during the presentation.
- 3. A short section may be added to the presentation to explain the background and historical context of the selection.
- 4. 4-H members are encouraged to dress in the time period and manner of the original speaker or audience. This is optional.
- 5. No props, or audiovisuals allowed.
- 6. Hands must not touch the floor, and one foot must remain on the floor at all times.
- 7. The entire presentation must be the original work of the 4-H member and abide by all copyright laws. All images and music must be cited correctly.
- 8. You must present your presentation in person.
- 9. The judge will serve as timekeeper.
- 10. Topics, visuals, props, language, and attire should be family-friendly and not violate the Kansas 4-H Code of Conduct.
- 11. Judge will deduct one ribbon placing if time is exceeded by more than 30 seconds.
