Rules:

- 1. The 4-H member will draw three topics and choose one to speak on.
- 2. Topics not selected are returned to the pool to be drawn by another competitor.
- 3. Participant will have 5 minutes to prep.
- 4. Prep time arrangements will be left to the County/District at their competitions. Regional 4-H Presentation Day Prep Time will be done in the room with the judge.
- 5. No outside resources may be brought into the prep area.
- 6. The 4-H member must speak about the topic selected and clearly state the topic in the speech's introduction.
- 7. You must present your presentation in person.
- 8. The judge will serve as the timekeeper.
- 9. Topics, visuals, props, language, and attire should be family-friendly and not violate the Kansas 4-H Code of Conduct.
- 10. Judge will deduct one ribbon placing if time is exceeded by more than 30 seconds.
