AT for August (Description)

Tick Talk - AT by Bob Burns

Ticks are a part of life in Kansas, albeit a less welcome one, especially given their reputation as carriers of diseases to humans. If you have been outside in Kansas, chances are you've encountered ticks.

While these tiny creatures play their role in the ecosystem, their potential to affect human health cannot be overlooked. Understanding the habits of ticks and the risks associated with them is the first step toward minimizing their impact on our health.



This presentation will cover what has been learned about the seasonal abundance of ticks in our state, their disease-carrying capabilities, and how we can coexist safely with these little critters. The discussion will help you understand the peak times of tick activity and define some measures to minimize the risks ticks pose.
